# 1. Android Auto Connection with IVI

## 1.1. Wired connections of Android Auto

For accessing Android Auto feature, Android Auto Mobile App needs to be installed on user's Android™ based Handset/Smartphone.

### 1.1.1. Android Auto installation

Android Auto App can be easily available on Google Play store of Android™ based Handset/smartphone. This app needs to be downloaded & installed on use's Handset/Smartphone.

### 1.1.2. Wired Connection

- For wired connection, use appropriate cable to Mobile to IVI System in the car. When user connect the cable then it will show that the device is getting connected.

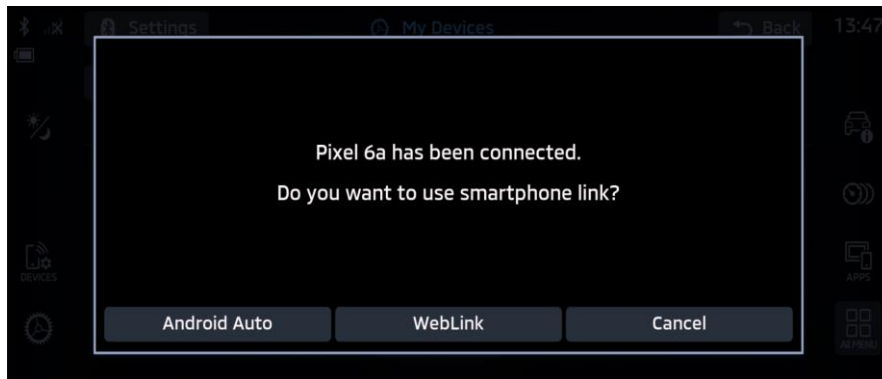


Figure 1: Settings - Connections Setting\_Smartphone link\_PP

- In the Home screen at Launcher side, tap "Android Auto" icon, the IVI system displays the Android Auto main Screen.

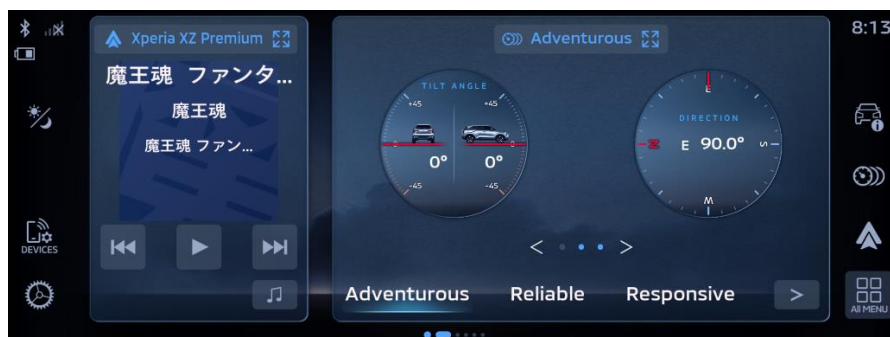
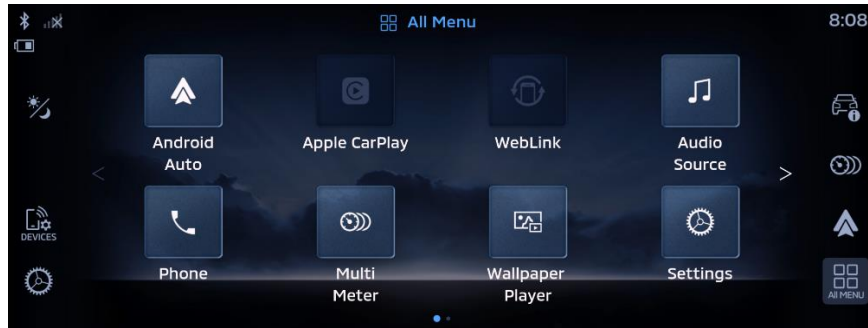


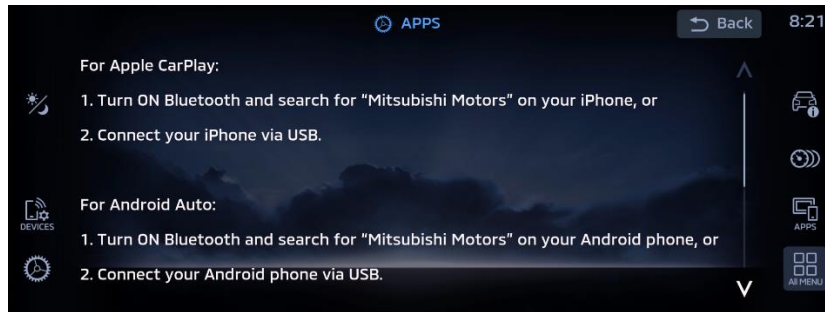
Figure 2: Home Screen – with Media Android Auto (1/3)

- In the Home screen, tap “Menu” icon. The IVI system displays the All-Menu Screen with the list of apps.



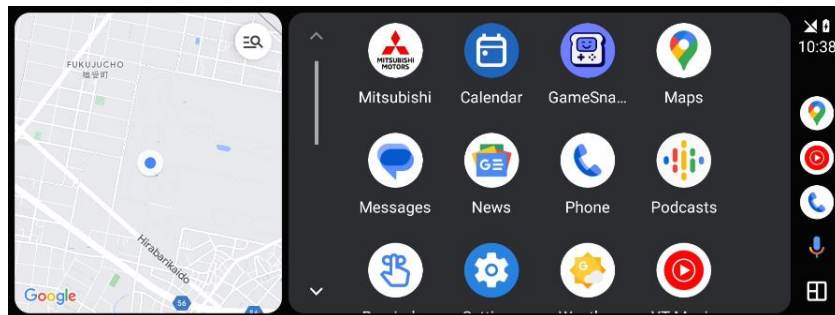
**Figure 3: Menu1 Screen**

- In the **All-Menu** Screen, tap “Android Auto” icon. The IVI system displays the Android Auto main screen.
- Applicable for both wired and wireless: - In the Home screen (at launcher side), tap “Apps” icon. The IVI system displays the Instructions to start Android Auto.

## 1.2. Wireless connections of Android Auto

For accessing Android Auto feature, Android Auto Mobile App needs to be installed on user's Android™ based Handset/Smartphone.

### 1.2.1. Android Auto installation

Android Auto App can be easily available on Google Play store of Android™ based Handset/smartphone. This app needs to be downloaded & installed on use's Handset/Smartphone.

### 1.2.2. Wireless Connection

- There are two ways to connect your phone wirelessly to the IVI system in the Car.
  1. Connection initiated from mobile device
  2. Connection initiated from IVI Unit
- Click on “DEVICES” icon to follow further steps.

#### 1. Connection initiated from mobile device

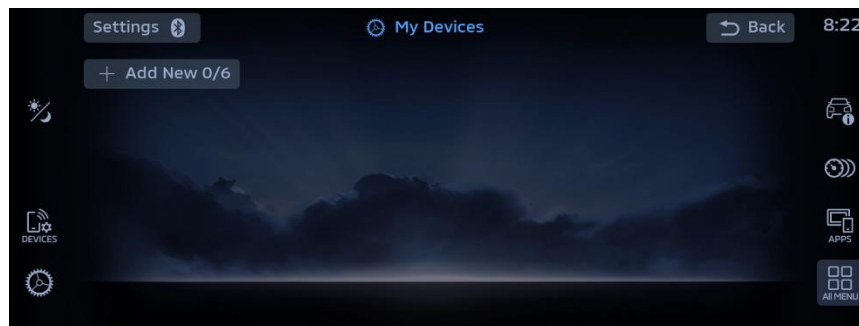


Figure 7: Settings - Connections Setting\_Bluetooth ON Screen

- Initially when no device is connected, Figure 7 screen will be available.

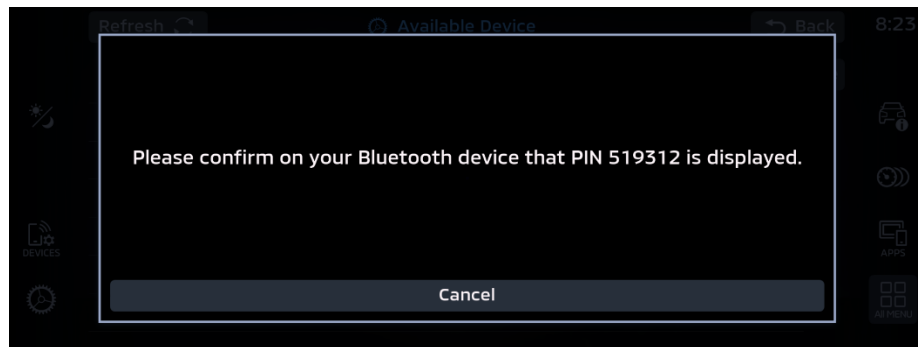
- To connect through mobile device wirelessly, connect Android™ based handset/smartphone through Bluetooth.
  - First turn on Bluetooth and device visibility on your smartphone.

- To connect through mobile device, Select “Mitsubishi Motors Bluetooth” on mobile device.

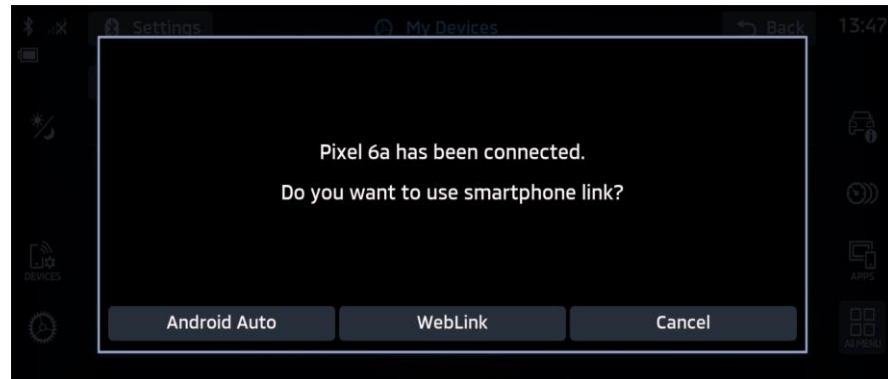
**Figure 9:** Settings - Connections Setting\_BT PIN Display confirm\_PP

- After selecting “Mitsubishi Motors Bluetooth” pin confirmation popup appears on IVI (Figure 9). Verify same pin on mobile device.

- Once the user confirms the passkey it will start to verify.



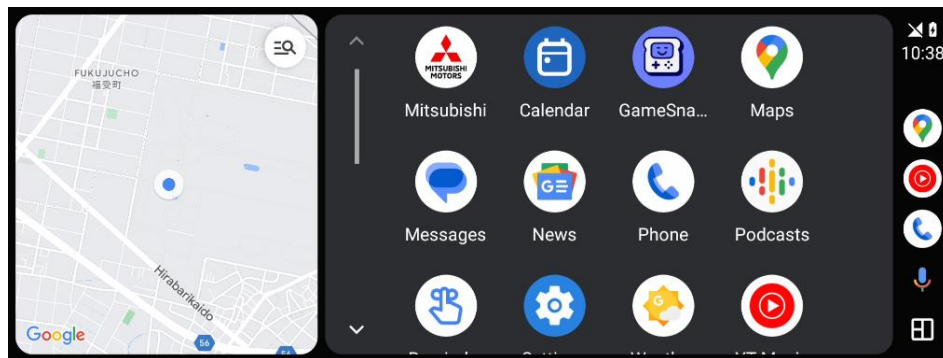
**Figure 10:** Settings - Connections Setting\_BT Passkey Verify\_PP

## 2. Connection initiated from IVI Unit

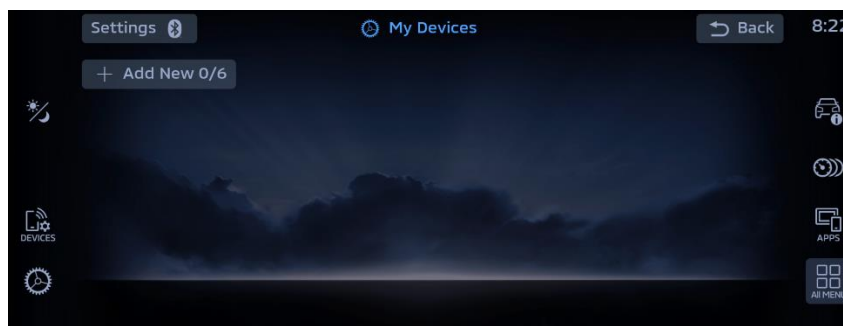
- Click on “DEVICES” icon to follow further steps.

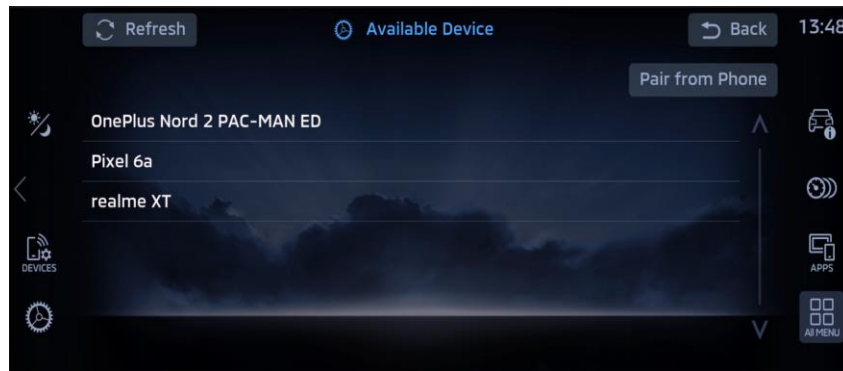
**Figure 14:** Settings - Connections Setting\_Bluetooth ON Screen

- Initially when no device is connected, Figure 14 screen will be available.

- For connecting from IVI Unit user must click on “Pair from Unit” button, then available devices list will appear.



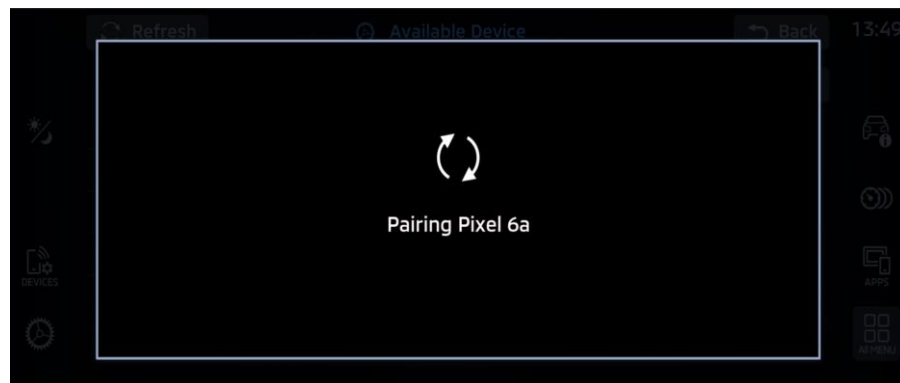
**Figure 15:** Settings - Connections Setting\_BT\_Add New Device

- In the Available Devices screen, scroll through the list of devices and select your phone.



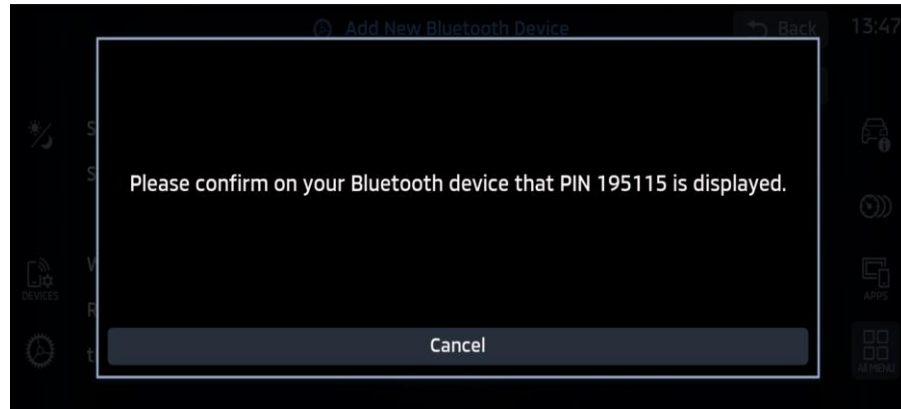
**Figure 16:** Settings - Connections Setting\_Available Device

- After selecting "Mitsubishi Motors Bluetooth", pin confirmation popup appears on IVI (Figure 9). Verify same pin on mobile device.



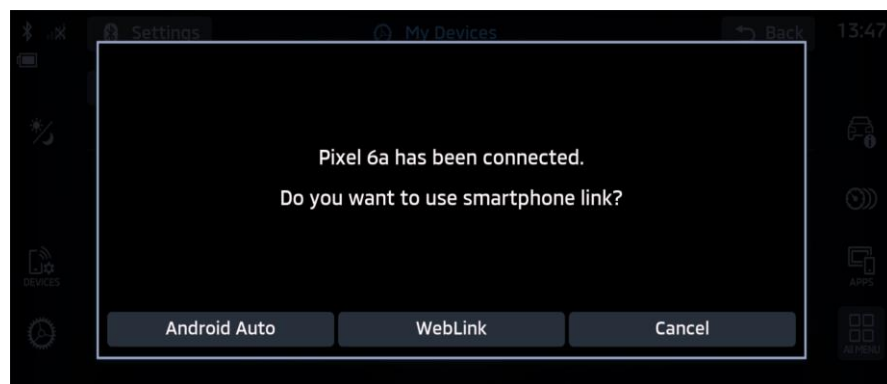
**Figure 18:** Settings - Connections Setting\_BT PIN Display confirm\_PP

- Once user confirm the passkey it will start to verify.



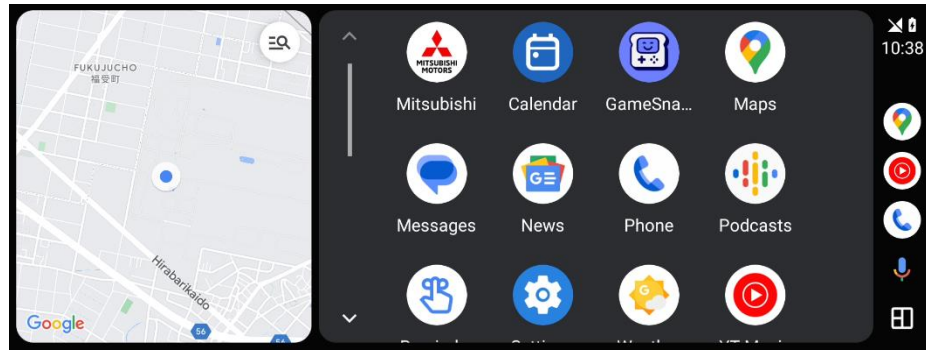
**Figure 19:** Settings - Connections Setting\_BT Passkey Verify\_PP
